


CAST OF CHARACTERS




PLAYWRIGHT & DIRECTOR



JEFF DANIELS (Playwright & Director) has now premiered twenty one full-length plays at The Purple Rose: Shoe Man, The Tropical Pickle, The Vast Difference, Thy Kingdom's Coming, Escanaba in da Moonlight, Apartment 3A, Boom Town, Across the Way (2002 American Theatre Critics Association Best New Play Finalist), Norma & Wanda, Guest Artist (2006 ATCA Runner-Up), Escanaba In Love, Panhandle Slim & The Oklahoma Kid, Escanaba, Best of Friends, The Meaning of Almost Everything (2013 ATCA Nominee), Casting Session, Flint, Diva Royale, Roadsigns, and Pickleball.

Jeff has written pieces for the New York Times' Sunday Arts & Leisure Section, American Theatre Magazine, McSweeney's, Nora Guthrie's Woody Guthrie: Songs And Art, Words And Wisdom, and the forewords to Dave Hoekstra's The Camper Book: A Celebration of a Moveable American Dream, and How To Quit Golf by Craig Brass. Jeff has also written three screenplays: "Escanaba in da Moonlight", "Super Sucker", and "Guest Artist".

Drawing from over twenty years of *Onstage & Unplugged* performances at The Purple Rose, Daniels has written an audio memoir called, "Alive And Well Enough" which is available on Audible.com. As a Director, Jeff helmed Lanford Wilson's *Hot L Baltimore* (1997) as well as his own plays: *Boom Town* (1998) and the remount of *Diva Royale* (2023). On film, he wrote, directed, and starred in two independent features: "Escanaba in da Moonlight" (2001) and "Super Sucker" (2002), both shot in Michigan.
